



Mandurah Southern Districts Bush Fire Brigade is situated at 2204 Old Coast Rd Herron. We currently have a Light Tanker, 3.4 Pump Unit and a support vehicle on station.

Our primary role is to service the needs of our local community, which extends from Tims Thicket Road to Lake Clifton

However as a DFES station we are also called upon to support other fire fighters as far away as Whitby and Gin Gin.



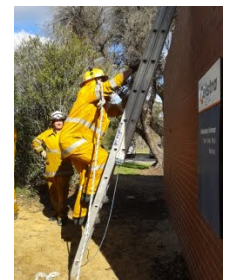
We recently amalgamated with the Mandurah SES, and anticipate that this will increase the involvement of our members in the fire “off season” as we will now be on hand to assist the SES on call outs south of the Dawesville Bridge.

Training takes place each Sunday during winter, and Tuesday nights and Sundays during the summer. Usually training is held on station, unless a Prescribed Burn or other training has been organised. We also actively participate in DFES approved training, including Structural Fire, Radio, Advanced Bush Fire Fighting, and On/Off road driving courses. All volunteers go through a basic training course before they attend any incident, and are provided with Level 1 Bush Fire

Personal Protective Equipment.

Monthly meetings are held on station on the last Sunday of the month, usually followed by a BBQ.
